Woolford, of Dorchester County, State of Maryland, do hereby manumit and set free my negro slave Harriet woman, which I have hired of James Craig adw of Samuel Craig, Sec. she being forty five years of age, of good health sound and capable of making a living, here freed and to commence from this second day of March 1858.

John Gore To Sundry negroes Be it remembered and it is hereby Certified, that the following Deed of Manumission was received and recorded on the 16th day of March, 1858, to wit: I, John Gore, of Dorchester County, and State of Maryland, do hereby manumit and set free my negro man Perry Demard, aged thirty eight years the fourth day of December, in the year Eighteen hundred and fifty seven, his freedom to commence from the date of these presents, also my negro man Charles Demard, aged thirty eight the twentieth day of June, the present year, his freedom to commence from the date of the end of the present year Eighteen hundred & fifty eight.
