Be it remembered and it is hereby Certified, that the following Deed of Manumission was received and recorded on the 27th April 1858, to wit
I, Anthony C. Thompson, of Dorchester County and State of Maryland do hereby Manumit & set free my negro slave Betty Manoby, her freedom to commence from the first day of January (1863) Eighteen hundred & sixty three, I also manumit & set free my negro child named James Henry, aged about three months, his freedom to commence on the first day of January, Eighteen hundred & eighty eight, I also manumit & set free my negro slave child Martino Kiah, aged about six months, her freedom to commence on the first day of January Eighteen hundred and eighty eight, I also manumit & set free my negro slave child Walter Scott Dyer, aged about two years her freedom to commence on the first day of January, Eighteen hundred & eighty six.
