





Hubbard, the following property, one light Brown Horse, one White Horse, two sorrel Colts, one black cow, three red and white Cows, one red and Black and white stear, one red and white stear, one Black calf, one motly calf, five red Calves, thirty white sheep, one four wheel Carriage, twenty white hogs, ten spotted hogs, two ore Cates, one wheat fan, one horn sheller, three beads, one bureau, one side Board. Provided, that if the said Charles S. Hubbard, Jr. shall pay to the said Caleb C. Hubbard, the sum of Six hundred and twenty five Dollars, with the interest thereon, on or before the first day of January, Eighteen hundred and sixty, then these presence shall be void.
