No. J. 423 folios 365 & 366 one of the Chattel records of Dorchester County & also acquit & exonerate the said Maquire of the sum of money therein expressed to be due me & release the property therein mentioned as pledged for the payment thereof. Robinson his heirs executors administrators and assigns forever, One negro girl called Rose Ann about Eleven years old, One negro girl named Hester Ann about Twelve years old and one negro Boy named William Bishop about nine years old - To Have and to Hold the above mentioned negroes unto the said Roger C. Robinson his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and benefit and behoof of the said Roger C. Robinson his heirs and assigns forever. Witness my hand and seal this twenty Eighth day of December Eighteen Hundred and fifty two.
