Sealed with our seals, and dated this twenty eighth day of June, in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and fifty eight. — The Condition of the above obligation is such, that if the above bound Thomas Stacke, Junior, appointed Collector of the second Election District of Dorchester County, shall well and faithfully execute his office, and the several duties required of him by law, and shall well, and truly account for and pay to the County Commissioners of Dorchester County, or their order, the several sums of money which he shall receive, or be answerable for by law, at such time as the law shall direct, then the above obligation to be void.
