Sealed with our seals, and dated this 5th day of July, in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and fifty eight. The Conditions of the above obligation is such, that if the above named Alexander Woolfard, appointed Collector of the Direct Tax for Election District number Two, for Worcester County, shall well and faithfully execute the Office of Collector of the Direct Tax, for the fourth Election District for said County, and the several duties required of him, by law, and shall well and pay to the Treasurer of Maryland, the several sums of money which he shall receive or be answerable for by law, at such time, as the law shall direct, then the above obligation to be void, or else to be and remain in full force and virtue in law.
