The State of Maryland Be it remembered and it is hereby certified, that the following Bond was from Alexander Woolfado received, and recorded, on the 13th the day of July, A. D. 1858, to wit:— Know all men by these presents, that we Alexander Woolfado, Thomas Woolfado, Joseph Brooks, Peter Harrington and James Craig, of Darchester County, in the State of Maryland, are held and firmly bound unto the State of Maryland in the full and just sum of Seven thousand two hundred and ten Dollars and sixty three Cents, Current money of the United States, to be paid to the said State, or its certain attorney, to the which payment well and truly to be made and done, we bind ourselves, and each of us, our and each of our heirs, executors and administrators, jointly and severally firmly by these presents. Sealed with our seals, and dated this 5th day of July, in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and fifty eight. — The condition of the above obligation is such, that if the above bounden Alexander Woolfado, appointed Collector for the Fourth Election District of Darchester County, shall well and faithfully execute his Office, and the several duties required of him by law, and shall well and truly account for, and pay to the County Commissioners for Darchester County, or their order, the several sums of money which he shall receive or be answerable for by Law, at such time as the law shall direct, then the above obligation to be void, or else to be and remain in full force and virtue in law. —
