and dated this third day of July, Anno Domini, Eighteen hundred and fifty eight. The Condition  
of the above obligation is such, that if the above named John R. Gray, appointed to be Collector  
of Direct Tax for Vienna district, or District number three, and for the Drawbridge district, or District  
number eleven, both in Dorchester County, State of Maryland, shall well and faithfully execute the  
Office of Collector of the Direct Tax, for said Districts in said County, and all and several the
