Gray, appointed to be Collector of Direct Tax for Vienna district, or district number three, and for the Crawbridge district, or District number eleven, both in Chester County, State of Maryland, shall well and faithfully execute the Office of Collector of the Direct Tax, for said Districts in said County; and all and several the duties required of him by law; and shall well and truly account for, and pay to the Treasurer of Maryland, the several sums, or sum of money which he shall receive, or be answerable for by Law, at such time as the law shall direct, then the above obligation to be void, else to be and remain in full force and virtue in law.—
