



County, State of Maryland, in consideration of One Hundred and eighty
Dollars paid me by Samuel Keene, residence of said County and State, do
hereby bargain and sell to the said Samuel Keene, negro man slave belonging to the Estate of
the said Moses L. Keene, deceased, and sold by the said Jeremiah L. Pattison as Executor,
Wheeler Prop. for the sum of Eleven years from the first of March, Eighteen Hundred and
fifty eight, the said negro being a slave for the sum or term of Eleven Years from the first of
March 1858, and no longer, and the said Jeremiah L. Pattison, being entitled to the said Slave
for the whole of said term. - Witness our hands and seals this 19th day of August 1858.

Bore of cream, Matt of Noah, four cows, three calves, ten heads of hogs, one ore cart, one waggon,
& harness, one old Gig, one Wheat fan, one new Corn Cradle, four plows, four harrows, Hauss
