Be it remembered and it is hereby certified, that the following Bill of Sale, was received and recorded on the 3^d day of December, Anno Domini, 1858, to wit: Know all men by these presents, that I, Bargillai Moore of Dorchester County, in the State of Maryland, for & in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred Dollars & twenty five Cents, Current money, to me in hand paid by Sarah Moore, my lawful wife, of Dorchester County, in the said State, at & before the sealing and delivering of these presents, the receipt whereof I the said Bargillai Moore, do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained, and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain & sell unto the said Sarah Moore, her executors, administrators & assigns: all the Goods & Chattels herein mentioned, viz: thirty five head of Hogs, they & all their increase, one Steer & 1 Bull, 1 Cow & Calf, 1 White back steer yearling, 1 White Back Cow, 1 Brindle heffer, 1 do. with a white face, 1 do Black & white face, 1 Bull Yearling, 2 Sheep, 2 ore Cows, 2 Hens & Coos, 2 ploughs & Chains, 5 hoes, 2/3 of the Crap of Corn & Drivender, all and singular, which said Goods and Chattels are remaining standing & being on & about the farm which I, B. Moore, now occupy & belonging to R. M. Tubman, lying in Lakes District, Dorchester County, Md. To have & to hold all & singular the said Goods & Chattels, above bargained and sold, or mentioned & intended so to be, to the said Sarah Moore, her Executors, administrators & assigns forever, & I the said B. Moore, for myself, my heirs, Executors and Administrators, all & singular the said Goods & Chattels, unto the said Sarah Moore, her Executors, Administrators and assigns, against me the said B. Moore, my Executors, administrators and assigns, all and every other persons or persons whatsoever, shall & will warrant & forever defend by these presents, of all & singular which said Goods & Chattels, which I, B.
