

Jones, of Dorchester County Maryland, in the sum of Three hundred and thirty dollars, with interest from the thirtieth day of June Eighteen hundred and fifty nine, in consideration thereof I as hereby bargain and sell to the said William W. Jones the following property viz, 3 head of Horses, 2 Ox carts, 3 Cows of Oxen, 7 head of young Cattle, 3 cows, 18 head of sheep, 5 head of hogs, Sows, Shoats, & pigs, together more or less, 1 horse trap, also the crop of Corn, now lying on the ground where I now live, also crop of Wheat & Oats, on the same farm, and also all my household and kitchen furniture and all the residue on the said farm. Provided, that if J. the said James Hughs shall pay to the said William W. Jones, the sum of Three hundred and thirty dollars, with interest thereon, on or before the thirtieth day of June A.D. 1862, then these present shall be void.
