I Juliana L. Muir of Dorchester County and State of Maryland  
for and in consideration of the sum of Seventy five Dollars Current  
money to me in hand paid by William Kirby of the County and State  
aforesaid, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents,  
the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted, bargained  
and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell to wit to the  
Said William Kirby his Executors, administrators, and assigns the  
following property to wit, one negro girl called Margant aged two  
months on the thirteenth day of January in the year of our Lord,  
One thousand eight hundred and fifty seven to serve as a slave  
until she attains to the age of thirty years, as by reference to the last  
Will and Testament of Ann L. Muir recorded in Liber T. H. A number  
two folios thirty two and thirty three one of the Will Record Books  
for Dorchester County will more fully and at large appear the  
said negro girl Margant now being in the possession of the said William  
Kirby To have and to hold, the said negro girl Margant as above  
specified to the said William Kirby his Executors, administrators,  
and assigns, to his and their only proper use and benefit and I the  
said Juliana L. Muir for myself, my heirs, Executors and  
administrators shall and will warrant and defend by these  
presents to the said William Kirby his heirs, Executors adminis-  
trators and assigns the said negro girl Margant as above speci-  
fied against me, my Executors, administrators and against  
all and every other person or persons whomsoever claiming  
the same. Witness our hands and seals this sixth day of May  
in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and fifty  
nine
