 Seven and then to be free. The said negro called Sarah Catharine
 Stevens being a slave for the time herein before mentioned and
 described, and the said Thomas Lambdin and Margant Lamb-
 din being entitled to said slave for the whole of said term
 herein before referred to. Witness our hands and seals this
 Twenty second day of March Eighteen hundred and fifty
 nine.
