Two Milch Cows, One Sail Boat & Skin Boat, Skin & Appurtenances, all my Household goods & chattels other than that owned by and belonging to my wife. Provided that if I the said James Vickers shall pay to the said Thomas Vickers, the said sum of Twelve hundred & Fifty dollars, with the interest thereon on or before the first day of January Eighteen hundred & sixty, then these presents shall be void. Provided that in default of payment the said Thomas Vickers, may sell the above mortgaged property in the following manner to wit, at public sale giving ten days notice by advertisement, in hand bills set up at the Court House and other Public of the time, place & terms of Sale which may be for Cash or Short Credit at the discretion of the said Thomas Vickers
