 my two negro slaves, Roman Mauletta and infant boy child
 George each to serve as slaves for the following term of years, and then
 to revert to the said W. D. W. Raleigh, his representatives or assigns
 the Mauletta to serve fifteen years from the first day of January
 last, Boy child George to serve thirty nine years from the first
 day of January last, all other children the issue of the said
 Mauletta during her servitude with the said Willey are to be
 slaves for life Witness my hand and seal this 28th day of February
 in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty nine
