Twenty Baulks, Corn mowers, three ploughs, three hammers, top & blade Hodder, the farm, <sup>now</sup> Lot of straw, One Sleigh, One saddle, One Saw & six pigs, Two Stye Hogs, One Buffalo robe, Shovels, Spades, and forks, One roller, One set Chain bottom chairs, Witness my hand & seal this 31<sup>st</sup> day of January A.D. 1859.
