 the said Daniel N. James doth hereby acknowledge hath, granted bargained and sold, & by these
 presents doth give, grant bargain & sell unto the said Lewis Ross Jr his executors administrators and assigns
 a dark Chestnut bay mare Called Fanny, and a grey horse Called John Richards, To Have
 & To Hold the said mare Called Fanny & the said Horse Called John Richards unto the said
