To all to whom these presents shall come,
Know ye, that I, Charles Jackson of Dorchester County and
State of Maryland of the first part, for securing the payment of the
Money hereinafter mentioned and in consideration of the sum of
One dollar to me hereinafter paid by Alexander H. Hurley of the
County and State aforesaid of the second part, at or before the
executing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is
hereby acknowledged, have bargained and sold and by these
presents, do grant, bargain, and sell unto the party of the second part
all of my horse hold and kitchen furniture, One Mare named
Polly, One gelding called John, One yoke of Oxen, Ox Cart,
Yoke & chains &c. Four head of Cattle, and fifteen head of Hogs
to have and to hold all and singular the goods & chattels
above bargained and sold or intended hereby to be, unto the
said party of the second part, his Executors, Administrators and
Assigns, forever. And I, the said Party of the first part for
myself, my heirs, Executors & Administrators all and singular
the goods and chattels above bargained and sold unto the said
party of the second part, his heirs, Executors Administrators and
Assigns, against me, the said party of the first part and against
all and every person or persons, whomsoever shall and will
infringe, and forever defend, upon Condition that if I, the
party of the first part, shall and do will and truly pay unto
the said party of the second part, his ~~his~~ Executors Administrators
or Assigns, the sum of One hundred and twenty dollars with
such interest and costs, as may or might accrue thereon, on or
before the seventh day of February Anno Domini Eighteen hundred
and sixty, And I, the said party of the first part for myself
my Executors, Administrators and Assigns, do Covenant & agree
to and with the said party of the second part his Executors Admini-
strators and Assigns, that in case default of payment shall be made
of the said sum above mentioned then it shall and may be lawful
for and the said party of the first part do hereby authorize and
empower the said party of the second part his Executors Admini-
strators and Assigns, with the aid and assistance of any person
or persons to enter my dwelling house or houses, or other
premises, and such other place or places as the goods or

delivered Jan'y 27th 1863, to A. H. Hurley.
