Thompson of Caroline County in the State of Maryland for and in Consideration of the sum of Four hundred and Fifty Dollars to me in hand paid by John D. Parker of Dorchester County in the State of Maryland Have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said John D. Parker two negroes viz one negro boy called George Brown aged about nine years in August 1852, whom I own for a term of years to serve him the said Parker until he shall arrive at the age of thirty years, that is to say for the term of twenty one years from the first day of January 1853 also one negro girl called Charlotte Brown aged about seven years in August 1852 whom I own for a term of years to serve him the said Parker until she shall arrive at the age of thirty years - that is to say for the term of twenty three years from the first day of January 1853 To Have and To Hold the said negroes above mentioned unto the said John D. Parker (the said George Brown for the term of twenty one years from the first day of January 1853 or until he is thirty years old and the said Charlotte Brown for the term of twenty three years from the first day of January 1853 or until she is thirty years old) his heirs executors administrators and assigns against me the said Anthony P. Thompson my heirs executors, and administrators and against all and every other person or persons shall and will warrant and defend, In witness whereof the said parties have hereunto set their hands and seals this eighth day of April 1853
