that if the above bound Richardson S. Richardson, appointed collector of the
Ninth Election District of Dorchester County shall well and faithfully execute
his office and the several duties required of him by law, and shall well
and truly account for and pay to the County Commissioners for Dorchester
County or their order, the several sums of money which he shall receive or be
answerable for by law, at such time as the law shall direct then the above
obligation to be void, or else to be and remain in full force and virtue
