Williams, all of Dorchester County, in the State of Maryland are held and firmly bound unto the State of Maryland, in the full and just sum of Fifteen hundred Dollars Current money to be paid to the said State or its certain attorney to the which payment well and truly to be made and done, we bind ourselves and each of us, our and each of our heirs, executors and administrators, jointly and severally, by these presents, Sealed with our seals, and dated this thirtieth day of July in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and fifty nine: The condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bound Thomas Stack, Junior, appointed Collector of the Direct Tax of the Second Election District for Dorchester County shall well and faithfully execute the office of Collector of the Direct Tax of the Second Election District for Dorchester County and the several duties required of him by law, and shall well and truly account for, and pay to the Treasurer of Maryland, the several sums of money which he shall receive or be answerable for by law, at such time as the law shall direct: then the above obligation to be void otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue in law.
