Know all men by these presents that we William Creighton, William Pea & John P. Creighton of Dorchester County in the State of Maryland are held and bound unto the State of Maryland in the full and just sum of Fifteen thousand dollars Current money of the United States to be paid to the State of Maryland which payment shall well and truly be made and done: we bind ourselves and every of us, our and every of our heirs Executors and administrators in the whole and for the whole jointly and severally by these presents sealed with our seals and dated this 27th day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and fifty nine. The conditions of the above obligation are such that if the above bounden William Creighton shall well and truly discharge the duties of Treasurer of Primary Schools of Dorchester County according to Law then the above obligation shall be void. Otherwise it is to be and remain in full force and virtue in Law
