Richard Goldsborough my son, do hereby give unto my said Daughter Laura H. Goldsborough my servant girl Emily Sharpe aged about fourteen years, a slave for life

Be it remembered, and it is hereby certified that the following Bill of Sale was received and recorded on the 3d day of October 1859 to wit:

W. William P. Tall Administrator with the will annexed of Pittman Jones late of Dorchester County, deceased - by virtue of an order of the Orphans Court for said County passed on the thirteenth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty eight and now of record among the Minutes of the Proceedings of said Court in Liber A. V. P. Number One, folios two hundred and twenty six and two hundred and twenty seven did sell by public sale on the twenty seventh day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty eight unto John Bradshaw for the sum of three hundred and fifty dollars, Negro woman Sally and negro boy John belonging to the estate of said Pittman Jones, deceased, as by reference to said order and to account of sales of said negroes returned to the said Court on the twenty seventh day of September in the year aforesaid will more fully and at large appear.

In consideration of the sum of three hundred and fifty dollars paid me by John Bradshaw of Cambridge Dorchester County Maryland, do hereby bargain & sell to the said John Bradshaw the following negro slaves, Negro woman Sally to serve as a slave until the seventeenth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty three, and negro boy John to serve as a slave until the seventh day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety one - The said negroes Sally and John being slaves for the above specified times and no longer, under the terms of the will of said Pittman Jones deceased, and the order passed by the Orphans Court as aforesaid
