

tofore made by the said Jacob, to the said Henry, over & above all sales of Real &
Personal estate heretofore made by the said Henry to the said Jacob, & over and
above all transfers & assignments, and being so indebted, and being desirous of
better securing the payment of the said sum of money, and in consideration
thereof, do hereby bargain & sell to the said Jacob C. Nicholson, the following prop-
erty, to wit: The crop of wheat now in the ground. All the contents of my veget-
able Patch, Consisting of Sweet & Irish potatoes, Cabbages, Pute Pagar Turneps
Buckwheat, Melons &c; One seine & boat, Set of Carpenters Tools, A weir.

Provided, that if the said Henry D. Nicholson shall pay to the said
Jacob C. Nicholson the said sum of One Thousand Dollars with interest thereon
in four equal instalments, of one, two, three & four years from this date, then these
present shall be void
