Slave (Man) David Lockerman, who was Forty three years old the 22^d. day of December,
Eighteen hundred and fifty nine. Is about Five feet Eight or Ten Inches high. Is a dark
Black. Weighs about one hundred and sixty pounds. His Freedom to Commence from the
First day of March 1860.

C. Hollands his executors administrators or assigns One Miled Cow named
Blaze, One Miled Cow Cherry, One young Steer, One yearling, One Bedstead, bed
and furniture, one set of chairs, one rocking chair, to have and to hold the same
unto the said Richard C. Hollands, his executors, administrators or assigns forever
and I the said Wm. Dutton (F.N.) do covenant to warrant and defend the sale
of the above named property unto the said Richard C. Hollands his heirs
Executors, Administrators or assigns, against all and every person or persons
howsoever. Provided nevertheless that if the said Wm. Dutton (F.N.) shall and
will pay or cause to be paid unto the aforesaid Richard C. Hollands or to his
assigns the above named sum of fifty dollars, with the interest thereon, on or
before the twenty fifth day of December eighteen hundred and sixty, then in
that case this Bill of sale shall become void and of none effect else to be and
remain in full force and virtue in law. In witness whereof the said Wm. Dut-
