Nicols Wright Be it remembered and it is hereby Certified, that the following Bill of Sale, was received and read on the 5th day of May 1853 to Thomas Breewood Executor of James Moore, late of Nechester County deceased, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred and ninety nine Dollars, Current money to him in hand, paid by Nicols Wright of said County, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Thomas Breewood Executor aforesaid, has bargained and sold, conveyed and transferred, and by these presents, does bargain, sell, convey and transfer unto the said Nicols Wright, his heirs or assigns, all the right, title, claims and demands of the said James Moore, his heirs or assigns, of, in, to and out of one negro Woman named Margaret to serve fifteen years from the first day of January, Eighteen hundred and forty eight and no longer, also here negro child named Frederick as slave for life. To Have and To Hold, the right, title and interest of the said James Moore deceased, of in and to said negro Woman Margaret for said term, and here said child Frederick, for life, unto the said Nicols Wright his heirs or assigns to his and their sole use and uses and for no other use intent or purpose whatsoever.
