The Condition of the above obligation is such, that if the above bounden Thomas H. Coburn shall well and truly execute the Office of Coroner in all things thereto belonging and shall also well and faithfully execute and return all writs or other process to him directed and shall also pay and deliver to the person or persons entitled to receive the same all sums of money and to take all goods and chattels by him lawfully seized or taken agreeably to the direction of the writ, or other process under which the same shall have been lawfully seized or taken and shall also keep and detain in safe custody all and every person or persons committed to his custody or by him taken in execution or who shall be committed for want of bail without suffering them or any of them to escape or depart from his custody and shall also satisfy and pay all judgments which shall be rendered against him as Coroner and shall also well and truly execute and perform the several duties required of or imposed upon him by the laws of the State of Maryland, then this obligation to be void and of none effect else to be and remain in full force and virtue in Law
