I know all men by these presents, That Goodman Gootie of Chester County in the State of Maryland has held and firmly bound unto William Kirwan of the same County & State in the full and just sum of Fifty hundred dollars, Dollars, lawful money of the United States, to be paid to the said William Kirwan or to his certain attorney, executor, administrators or assigns to the payment whereof I bind myself my heirs executors or administrators firmly by these presents, sealed with my seal and dated this day of May in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty. Whereas the above bound Goodman Gootie hath sold to the aforesaid William Kirwan and contracted and agreed to grant, or cause and procure to be granted, to him in fee, the herein after described Land and improvements

In Consideration of the sum of One thousand dollars Current money to be paid as follows, That is to say the sum of five hundred and fifty three dollars and sixty five cents in money to be paid at or before the sealing and delivery hereof - and for the balance of four hundred and forty six dollars and thirty five cents to the said William Kirwan has made and passed to the said Goodman Gootie his promissory note bearing even date herewith and payable to the order of said Goodman Gootie for four hundred & forty <sup>six</sup> dollars and thirty five cents at three years after date with interest thereon from date till paid. the receipt of said money and promissory note is hereby acknowledged. Now the Condition of the foregoing obligation is such, that if upon payment of the whole purchase or Consideration money aforesaid, with interest thereon as secured by the above recited promissory note at the time limited by said note for the payment of the same, the said Goodman Gootie his heirs or assigns do and shall
