




Know all men by these presents that we Charles F. Goldsborough, Daniel M. Henry and Grier J. Goldsborough of Charles County, in the State of Maryland, are held and firmly bound unto the State of Maryland in the full and just sum of twenty thousand dollars, Current money to be paid to the said State of Maryland, or its certain attorney, to which payment, well and truly to be made and done, we bind ourselves and each of us, our and each of our heirs, executors and administrators, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and dated, this nineteenth day of May in the year eighteen hundred and sixty. Whereas, by a deed from Edwin S. Fote and Mary C. Fote, his wife to the above named Charles F. Goldsborough bearing date on the third day of October in the year eighteen hundred and fifty nine and recorded in Viles J. G. No. 4 folios 478, 479 & 480 One of the Land record Books for Charles County, certain real and personal estate therein named was conveyed to the said Charles F. Goldsborough, in trust for certain purposes mentioned in said deed

Now the condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bound Charles F. Goldsborough do and shall well and faithfully perform the trust reposed in him by the said deed the the above obligation to be void, otherwise to be and remain of full force and virtue in law
