

That we Emily Tyler, Nancy Tyler and of Dorchester County, in the State of Maryland for and in consideration of the sum of Two thousand Dollars Current money to us in hand paid by Henry Jefferson Bramble of Dorchester County in the State aforesaid at and before the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof we the said Emily Tyler, Nancy Tyler & do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained & sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain & sell unto the said Henry Jefferson Bramble, his executors administrators, and assigns, certain negroes, slaves for life, (said negroes were inherited by us the said Emily Tyler, Nancy Tyler & from our Grandfather Thomas Hurlock Dec'd.) viz' negro man named Moses Pennington supposed to be he about years of age, negro man William Pennington supposed to be about years of age, negro man James Pennington supposed to be about years of age, negro woman Hannah Pennington supposed to be about years of age, negro woman Eliza Pennington, supposed to be about years of age & infant child of said Eliza Pennington. To Have and To Hold, the said negroes Moses Pennington, William Pennington, James Pennington, Hannah Pennington & Eliza Pennington & child, above bargained and sold, or intended so to be, to the said Henry Jefferson Bramble, his executors, administrators and assigns forever. And we the said Emily Tyler, Nancy Tyler, for ourselves, our heirs executors & administrators, all and singular the said negroes namely Moses Pennington, William Pennington, James Pennington, Hannah Pennington & Eliza Pennington & infant child of said Eliza, as slaves for life unto the said Henry Jefferson Bramble, his executors, administrators and assigns, against us the said Emily Tyler, Nancy Tyler, & our executors, administrators and against all and every other person and persons whatsoever, shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents
