ton and James A. Waddell, my negro slave John. to serve as a slave until he
arrives at the age of thirty five years. when he is to be free under the will of
Reuben Tall late of said County. deceased, which said will is now of
record in the office of the Register of Wills for said County - also all my
right and title to negro woman Mary (purchased by me of James A.
Norman) whether as a slave for life or for a term of years and the said
Cooper C. Hicks being entitled to both of said slaves for the terms as above
specified - Witness our hands and seals this 21st day of April 1800
