Know all men by these presents that we George Winthrop, William Rea, John A. Scott and Olyza Cooper of Onchester County and State of Maryland are held and firmly bound unto the State of Maryland in the full and just sum of fifteen thousand dollars current money of Maryland to be paid to the said State of Maryland or its certain attorney, to which payment well and truly to be made and done, we do bind ourselves, our heirs, executors administrators and assigns jointly by these presents, sealed with our seals and dated this twentieth day of April in the year One thousand eight hundred and sixty

Whereas the above bounden George Winthrop has been appointed by the County Commissioners for Onchester County, treasurer of the School fund for said County in the year 1860

Now therefore the condition of the above obligation is such that if the said George Winthrop shall well and truly pay over to the Order of the School Commissioners of the respective Districts of said County the sum or sums to which they may be respectively entitled, and shall render to the County Commissioners a correct account of all monies received by him by virtue of his office, with an account of the disbursements of the same and shall well and faithfully discharge and execute all the duties pertaining to his office, then this obligation to be void otherwise to remain in full force and virtue in law
