Be it remembered and it is hereby Certified, that the following Bill of Sale was received and recorded on the 31st day of October 1853 to wit: Know all men by these presents, that I, Hugh Maguire of Dorchester County in the State of Maryland, for and in Consideration of the sum of Five Hundred Dollars Current money of Maryland, to me in hand paid by William W. Crawford of the same County and State aforesaid at and before the execution of these presents, the receipt whereof, the said Hugh Maguire, do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained, sold, conveyed and transferred and by these presents, do bargain and sell, transfer and Convey unto the said William W. Crawford, his Executors, administrators and assigns, and negro boy Called and Known by the name of Joseph aged about seventeen years, as slave for life, together with all my rights, title, interests, claims and demands, of in and to the said negro boy slave. To Have and To Hold, the said negro slave Joseph, above bargained and sold, or intended so to be, to the said William W. Crawford, his executors, administrators and assigns forever to him and their only use and behoof against him the said Hugh Maguire, his heirs and assigns and against all persons whatsoever, shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents. In Testimony whereof, the said Hugh Maguire, has hereunto subscribed his name and affixed his seal this nineteenth day of October, in the year of our Lords, Eighteen Hundred and Fifty three.
