Know all men by these presents, that I, John McCready of Chester County in the State of Maryland for and in Consideration of the sum of One Hundred & ninety five Dollars current money to me in hand paid, by George W McCready of the same County in the said State, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipts whereof I the said John McCready, do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained, and sold, and by these presents, do grant, bargain, and sell unto the said George W McCready, his Executors, administrators and assigns, all the goods, Household stuff, implements and furniture, hereinafter particularly mentioned, that is to say, Forty Panels of Lard, 2 stacks of Blade fadders and three stacks of top fadders, all and singular which said goods and Chattels are now in the possession and occupancy of the said John McCready. Do Have and Do Hold, all and singular the Goods, Household stuff and Furniture and other the premises above bargained and sold or mentioned and intended so to be to the said George W McCready, his Executors, administrators and assigns forever. And I the said John McCready for myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, all and singular the said Goods, Household stuff and furniture and other the premises, unto the said Geo. W. McCready his Executors, administrators and assigns, against me the said John McCready, my executors and administrators, and against all and every other persons or persons whatsoever, shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents, of all and singular which said goods Household stuff and Furniture, and other the premises I the said John McCready have put the said George W McCready have put the said George W McCready in full possession by delivering to him the said George W McCready one stack of Blade fadders, at the sealing and delivery of these presents, in the name of the whole premises hereby bargained and sold or mentioned or intended to be so unto him the said George W McCready as aforesaid.
