Richard M. Beall This indenture made this twenty fifth day of January in the year of our Lords eight hundred ande fifty foure, between Richard M. Beall of Dorchester County ande State of Maryland of the one part, ande Charles D. Goldsborough of the same County ande State of the other part: Whereas the saide Richard M. Beall, by his Bill obligatory, duly executed, bearing the same date with these presents, was ande stands justly indebted to the saide Charles D. Goldsborough, in the sum of eight hundred dollars, Current money to be paid on or before the first day of January eighteen hundred ande fifty five, with the legal interest for the same, as by the saide bill obligatory will more fully appear, ande to secure the paymente of the saide sum of eight hundred dollars with the legal interest for the same, is willing to execute these presents. Now this indenture witnesseth, that the saide Richard M. Beall, for ande in Consideration of the premises, ande of the sum of five dollars to him in hande paid by the saide Charles D. Goldsborough, at ande before the sealing ande delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted bargained ande sold ande by these presents doth grant bargain ande sell unto the saide Charles D. Goldsborough, his executors, administrators ande assigns, all ande singular the goods, Chattels ande personal property, hereinafter particularly mentioned ande expressed: that is to say, One half of the printing press, type, Cases, furniture ande materials, in the office of the Cambridge Chronicle, newspaper, all ande singular which said half of said printing press, type, Cases, furniture ande materials are now remaining, standing ande being, in a certain messuage or tenement situate in the town of Cambridge ande now in the occupation of the saide Richard M. Beall, being the same half of said printing press, type, Cases, furniture ande materials, which were conveyed by the saide Charles D. Goldsborough to the saide Richard M. Beall, by a Bill of Sale, duly executed ande bearing date the fifth day of January 1854, ande recorded in Liber D. J. H. no 2, folios 81 & 82 one of the Chattel Record books of Dorchester County. To Have ande to Hold, all ande singular the said half of said printing press, type, Cases, furniture ande materials, unto the saide Charles D. Goldsborough, his Executors administrators ande assigns to his ande thine own use ande behoof. Provide always, ande it is declared to be the true intent ande meaning of these presents, that if the saide Richard M. Beall do, ande shall well ande truly pay or Cause to be paid unto the saide Charles D. Goldsborough, his executors, administrators or assigns, the said full sum of eight hundred dollars, Current money with legal interest for the same, on or before the first day of January 1855, then, ande in such Case, these presents ande every matter ande thing herein containede, shall cease, determine ande be utterly void, to all intents ande purposes, any thing herein containede to the contrary notwithstanding.
