Robert D. Thompson of Dorchester County and State of Maryland have granted, bargained and sold,
and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto the said Robert D. Thompson his heirs and
assigns, the following negro boy John to serve until the last day of December eighteen hundred and
seventy according to the terms and limitation of Sarah Rawleighs last will and Testament
and order of the Orphans Court Slave for the term aforesaid, and not sound in body and mind. To
Have and To Hold the said negro boy John until the last day of December eighteen hundred and
seventy according to the limitation of the will aforesaid - as above bargained and sold unto the said Rob-
ert D. Thompson his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, against me the said James Thompson Execu-
tor of Sarah Rawleigh and his heirs, executors and administrators, and against all and every other
person or persons whatsoever, shall and will warrant and forever defend. In testimony whereof
I James Thompson Executor aforesaid, and have hereunto set their hands and affixed seals this twentieth
day of January eighteen hundred and fifty four
