Peter G. Seecombe } This indenture made this 27th day of January 1854 between Peter G. Seecombe
of Dorchester County and State of Maryland of the one part and Anthony C. Thompson of the State and
County aforesaid of the other Part whereas the said Peter G. Seecombe owes and stands justly indebted
to the said Anthony C. Thompson in the sum of Six Hundred and Twenty five dollars Current money
and to secure the payment thereof is willing to execute these presents now this indenture witnesseth that
the said Peter G. Seecombe for and in Consideration of the premises and of the sum of five dollars
Current Money to him in hand paid by the said Anthony C. Thompson at and before the sealing and delivery
of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained and sold and by these
presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Anthony C. Thompson his Executors administrators and assigns
all and singular two Negro men Slaves for life hereinafter mentioned and expressed that is to say one Negro
man Called Lawrence Howard aged 23 years and one Negro man Called Moses Hop aged 20 years To Have
and to Hold all and singular the said two Negroes above mentioned unto him the said Anthony C. Thompson
his Executors administrators and assigns to his and their own use and behoof Provided always and it is
declared to be the true intent and meaning of these presents that if the said Peter G. Seecombe do and shall well
and truly pay or Cause to be paid unto the said Anthony C. Thompson his Executors administrators or assigns
the full sum of six hundred and twenty five dollars one cent before the twentieth day of July 1855 with legal
interest on the same then and in such case these presents and every matter and thing contained herein
shall cease determine and be utterly void to all intents and purposes any thing herein contained to the contrary
in testimony whereof I the said Peter G. Seecombe have hereunto set my hand and seal the day and year
