THE FISCAL YEAR OF THE STATE IS THE FISCAL YEAR OF THE FUND.

THERE IS A BOARD FOR THE INJURED WORKERS' INSURANCE FUND.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from the first sentence of former Art. 101, § 71(a)(1), as that sentence related to creation of the Board.

The title "Board for the Injured Workers' Insurance Fund" is substituted for the former title "commissioners of the Injured Workers' Insurance Fund", to avoid the use of the individual title "commissione[r]" in the title of the unit and to avoid potential confusion with the Workers' Compensation Commission. Although the 1987 annual report of the Fund and the Report of the Governor's Task Force to Study the State Accident Fund used the name "Board of Commissioners of the [then] State Accident Fund", there did not seem to be a reason to preserve this longer name. This substitution is not intended to alter the term of any member of the Board. See § _____ of Ch. _____, Acts of 1991.
