

Subsection (c)(3) of this section also is added as standard language to maintain the existing terms. For circumstances under which subsection (c)(3) of this section applies, see the General Revisor's Note to this article.

Subsection (d) of this section is new language that repeats the provisions of Md. Constitution, Art. II, § 15. For other provisions on removal, see: Md. Constitution, Art. XV, § 2, on suspension and removal for crimes, and Art. 41, § 1-203 of the Code, on removal for failure to attend meetings.

Former Art. 101, § 66(8)(b)(iv), which required the Governor to fill vacancies "in the same manner as original appointments", is deleted as unnecessary in light of subsection (a) of this section.

10-209. MEETINGS; COMPENSATION.

(A) MEETINGS.

THE BOARD SHALL DETERMINE THE TIMES AND PLACES OF ITS MEETINGS.

(B) COMPENSATION AND REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES.

SUBJECT TO THE STATE BUDGET, EACH MEMBER OF THE BOARD IS ENTITLED TO:

(1) COMPENSATION FOR EACH DAY THAT THE MEMBER IS ENGAGED IN DUTIES OF THE OFFICE; AND

(2) REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS.

REVISOR'S NOTE: Subsection (a) of this section is standard language added for clarity.

Subsection (b) of this section is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 101, § 66(8)(e).

In subsection (b)(1) of this section, the phrases "for each day that a member is engaged in duties of the office" are substituted for the former phrases "for each day as a member of the Board", which suggested erroneously that a member receives compensation for each day during the term of the member, regardless of service on a particular day and which was inconsistent with the former adjective "per diem". In light of this substitution, the former adjective "per diem" is deleted as unnecessary.

In subsection (b)(2) of this section, the reference to the "Standard State Travel Regulations" is substituted for the former reference to reimbursement for "actual and incidental" expenses "of travel required for members of the Board". See SF § 10-203 and COMAR 23.02.01.01 through .12.
