

SUBTITLE 3. UNINSURED EMPLOYERS' FUND.

PART I. DEFINITIONS.

10-301. DEFINITIONS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(B) BOARD.

"BOARD" MEANS THE UNINSURED EMPLOYERS' FUND BOARD.

"FUND" MEANS THE UNINSURED EMPLOYERS' FUND.

10-304. ESTABLISHED.

THERE IS AN UNINSURED EMPLOYERS' FUND.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section formerly appeared as Art. 101, § 91(a), as that subsection related to creation of the Fund.

It is set forth as a separate section for emphasis.

No changes are made.

The Uninsured Employers' Fund Board notes, for consideration by the General Assembly, that the name of the Fund does not reflect its responsibility to pay an award when an employer or insurer fails to do so, or its responsibility to administer the Self-Insurers' Guaranty Fund. The Board suggests that the name Workers' Guaranty Fund may be more appropriate. As to the responsibility of the Fund to administer the Self-Insurers' Guaranty Fund, see Art. 48A, § 609(e).
