

health or social agency; or where it can be ascertained by the physician with a reasonable degree of medical certainty that the fetus is affected by genetic defect or serious deformity or abnormality; or where it can be ascertained by the physician with a reasonable degree of medical certainty that termination of pregnancy is medically necessary because there is substantial risk that continuation of the pregnancy could have a serious and adverse effect on the woman's present or future physical health; or before an abortion can be performed on the grounds of mental health there must be certification in writing by the physician or surgeon that in his or her professional judgment there exists medical evidence that continuation of the pregnancy is creating a serious effect on the woman's present mental health and if carried to term there is a substantial risk of a serious or long lasting effect on the woman's future mental health.

Further provided that \$74,134,000 of the General Fund appropriation shall be expended on reimbursements directly attributable to a provider specific tax or fee imposed by the Medical Assistance Program and provided further that \$74,134,000 of this General Fund appropriation and \$55,550,000 in Federal Fund appropriation shall be contingent upon enactment of legislation to impose a provider specific tax or fee by the Medical Assistance Program.

All appropriations provided for the program Medical Care Provider Reimbursements - 32.17.01.03 are to be used only for the purposes herein appropriated, and there shall be no budgetary transfer, unless funds are transferred to create a separate line item of expenditure for a Kidney Disease Program.
