

Furthermore, if the former references to an "action" and "prosecution" both are interpreted to refer to civil actions, part of former Art. 100, § 55D(b) would be rendered surplusage. On the other hand, interpretation of "prosecution" to have its usual meaning allows effect to be given to every word of former Art. 100, § 55D(b), in accordance with the rules of statutory construction.

A COURT MAY NOT REQUIRE THE COMMISSIONER OF LABOR AND INDUSTRY TO PAY FILING FEES OR OTHER COSTS IN CONNECTION WITH AN ACTION UNDER TITLE 3, SUBTITLE 5 OF THE LABOR AND EMPLOYMENT ARTICLE.

Article - Education

4-205.

(a) In addition to the other powers granted and duties imposed under this article, the county superintendent has the powers and duties set forth in this section.

(M) WORK PERMITS.

THE COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT SHALL PROVIDE THE CLERICAL HELP THAT IS NEEDED TO ISSUE WORK PERMITS IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 3-206 OF THE LABOR AND EMPLOYMENT ARTICLE.

Article - State Government

5-102.

(a) While in office, the Treasurer shall be covered by a surety bond as required in this section.

(b) The surety bond [of the Treasurer] UNDER THIS SECTION shall:

- (1) run to the State;
- (2) be in the amount that the Governor approves; [and]
- (3) be with a surety company that is authorized to do business in the State;

AND

(4) INCLUDE PROVISIONS THAT SECURE THE MONEY OF:
