

REVISOR'S NOTE: Chapter ____, Acts of 1991, which enacted the Labor and Employment Article, also enacted this section, which is derived without substantive change from the ninth sentence of former Art. 95A, § 10(b) and the second sentence of § 11(a)(1).

In subsection (b) of this section, the word "surety" is added to modify "bond", to conform to references elsewhere in the Code to this type of bond.

In subsection (b)(2)(i) of this section, the requirement that the surety bond "run to the State" is substituted for the former requirement to "give" a bond, for clarity.

(b) This subtitle does not apply to:

- (1) a unit in the Legislative Branch of the State government;
- (2) a unit in the Judicial Branch of the State government; [or]
- (3) THE INJURED WORKERS' INSURANCE FUND; OR
- (4) a board of license commissioners.

REVISOR'S NOTE: Chapter ____, Acts of 1991, which enacted the Labor and Employment Article, also amended subsection (b) of this section, to add item (3), and amended § 10-120(a) of this subtitle, to delete an exemption for the Injured Workers' Insurance Fund. These changes reflect that Chs. 584 and 585, Acts of 1987, removed the Fund from the Department of Personnel and exempted the Fund from all laws that affect governmental units, including this entire subtitle. See LA § 10-105(b). Therefore, the limited exemption under § 10-120(a) of this subtitle for only Part IV of this subtitle was misleading and has been deleted.

The addition of an express exemption in subsection (b)(3) of this section possibly is unnecessary. However, in light of the convoluted history of this subtitle, the Labor and Employment Article Review Committee concluded that the addition of subsection (b)(3) of this section would be helpful. - (1) the Governor;
- (2) the Department of Assessments and Taxation;
- (3) the Board of Appeals of the Department of Economic and Employment Development;
- (4) the Insurance Division of the Department of Licensing and Regulation;
