[(9)] (8) the [Workmen's] WORKERS' Compensation Commission.

REVISOR'S NOTE: Chapter ____, Acts of 1991, which enacted the Labor and Employment Article, also amended subsection (a) of this section to delete the limited exemption for the Injured Workers' Insurance Fund under this section, in light of the general exemption added to § 10-102(b) of this subtitle. SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 30(f)(2) and (3) of Article 89 – Division of Labor and Industry of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed and reenacted, with amendments, and transferred to the Session Laws, to read as follows:

[30.]

[(f) (2) Any industrial lead standards adopted prior to June 30, 1983 shall become applicable to all construction, demolition, and renovation projects in the State on July 1, 1983. Those sections of the industrial lead standards which are not feasible for application to construction, demolition, and renovation projects may be waived by the Commissioner.

(3)] The Commissioner OF LABOR AND INDUSTRY shall adopt lead standards for construction, demolition, and renovation projects by January 1, 1984. [Thereafter, the industrial standards applied under paragraph (2) of this subsection do not apply.]

SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Sections 26(c), 33(d), 36(8)(i), 36C(a) and (b), 71, and 98 of Article 101 – Workmen's Compensation of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed and reenacted, with amendments, and transferred to the Session Laws, to read as follows:

[26.] 1.

[(c) This article] THE MARYLAND WORKERS' COMPENSATION ACT shall not apply to cases of occupational disease in which the last injurious exposure to the hazard of such disease occurred before June 1, 1939.
