

CHAPTER 11

(House Bill 102)

AN ACT concerning

Somerset County – County Treasurer

FOR the purpose of providing that in Somerset County, the County Treasurer shall receive and collect all money due to the County, including license fees; and generally relating to the duties of the County Treasurer.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
The Public Local Laws of Somerset County
Section 7-105
Article 20 – Public Local Laws of Maryland
(1988 Edition, as amended)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 20 – Somerset County

7-105.

[(a) Except for license fees, the Treasurer is the collector of all State and County taxes levied for the County during the Treasurer's term of office.]

[(b)] (A) The Treasurer shall receive and collect all State and County taxes [that are levied and all money except for license fees, which is due] AND ALL OTHER MONEY DUE TO the County.

[(c)] (B) The Treasurer has full power to enforce the payment of taxes by sale or otherwise and to convey title to any real or personal property sold by the Treasurer for the payment of State and County taxes in the manner prescribed by this title.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.
