CHAPTER 16

(House Bill 293)

AN ACT concerning

Frederick County – Dinner Theater Alcoholic Beverages License

FOR the purpose of establishing a Class B-DT (Dinner Theater) on-sale beer, light wine and liquor license; providing for certain license qualifications, an annual license fee, and the scope of the license; providing for the days and time for operation under the license; and making this Act an emergency measure.

BY adding to

Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages

Section 19(1)(5)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages

19.

(1) (5) (I) THE FREDERICK COUNTY BOARD OF LICENSE COMMISSIONERS MAY ISSUE A SPECIAL CLASS B-DT (DINNER THEATER) ON-SALE BEER, LIGHT WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE FOR THE USE OF AN ESTABLISHMENT THAT:

1. IS OPERATED AS A DINNER THEATER;
2. PROVIDES LIVE BROADWAY-STYLE MUSICALS, COMEDY, OR DRAMA TO ITS CUSTOMERS;
3. IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC BY RESERVATION ONLY;
4. CONTAINS A DINING ROOM WITH FACILITIES FOR PREPARING AND SERVING FULL COURSE MEALS FOR AT LEAST 120 PERSONS AT ONE SEATING.
