

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, has been passed by a ye and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.

CHAPTER 18

(House Bill 393)

AN ACT concerning

Wildlife – Waterfowl Processing Operation

FOR the purpose of requiring that a waterfowl processing operation be licensed; prohibiting the Department of Natural Resources from charging a certain fee; establishing certain application procedures; establishing the duration of a license; prohibiting an operation from possessing wild waterfowl that are not properly tagged; requiring that certain records be kept; requiring that certain records be submitted to the Department; authorizing certain inspections by Natural Resources Police and certain other law enforcement officers; providing for suspension or revocation of a license under certain circumstances; defining a certain term; and generally relating to the licensing of waterfowl processing operations.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section(s) 10-101(v) through (aa), respectively, of Article – Natural Resources of the Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 10-101(w) through (bb), respectively.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
