[(a) In this section "employer" has the same meaning as under the State Workmen's Compensation Laws.

(b)] Before any license [is] MAY BE issued under this subtitle to an employer to engage in an activity in which the employer may employ [any individual] A COVERED EMPLOYEE, AS DEFINED IN § 9-101 OF THE LABOR AND EMPLOYMENT ARTICLE, the employer shall file with the Administration:

(1) a certificate of compliance with the [State Workmen's] MARYLAND WORKERS' Compensation [Laws] ACT; or

(2) the number of a [workmen's] WORKERS' compensation insurance policy or binder.

(a) In this subtitle the following words have the meanings indicated.
