

(h) Venue shall be determined in accordance with the provisions of § 6-201 of this article.

(i) The clerk of the court shall file a copy of the verdict or any other final disposition with the Director.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, has been passed by a ye and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.

CHAPTER 26

(House Bill 1188)

AN ACT concerning

Education – Public Schools – Day Care Programs

FOR the purpose of authorizing county boards of education to lease certain school property for the construction or operation of group day care centers under certain circumstances; making technical corrections; generally relating to the use of certain school property by group day care centers; providing for the retroactive effect of this Act on certain leases; and making this Act an emergency measure.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Education

7-108.

(a) Each county board shall encourage the use of public school facilities for community purposes.

(b) (1) If written application is made to the county superintendent, the county board shall provide for the use of a public school facility for:

(i) The presentation and discussion of public questions;
